The Esher Hall
Antiques & Fine Art Fair

7 - 9 October 2016

The annual Esher Hall Antiques & Fine Art Fair took place at Esher Hall, Sandown Park Racecourse, Esher, Surrey KT10 9AJ for the ninth occasion, from 7 to 9 October 2016, and saw a steady stream of visitors over the three days. Many of them commented on the ideal size of the event.

The opening morning was a hive of activity with a plethora of sales of Chinese ceramics from Catherine Hunt Oriental Antiques, a carriage clock from Richard Price, jewellery from T Robert, silver from S & A Marsh, books from Nicholas Daly, champagne glasses from Brian Watson Antique Glass and furniture from Melody Antiques, all before mid-day.

Margaret Cowley of Garret & Hurst Sculpture said, "There is a much more optimistic feeling. We have had more sales here today (opening day) than at some of the big London fairs. There appears to be more interest and people are willing to buy. The visitors coming in are the right calibre and are interested in our 19th century and contemporary sculptures". Garret & Hurst Sculpture sold four bronzes including *Giraffe Running* by contemporary wildlife sculptor Robert Glen for £15,500.

First time exhibitor to the fair, Lucy Campbell of Lucy B Campbell Gallery said, "It's a lovely fair. Ingrid Nilson organises it so beautifully. We sold two paintings by Anna Pugh and Manuel López Herrera, one of which was bought for a large house still being built in Surrey."

Richard Price, of BBC Antiques Roadshow fame, sold several clocks including his best carriage clock to a Sussex couple and a large impressive four glass French mantle clock to the owners of a very large house nearby. "My best fair ever", he beamed!

Other good sales included a late 17th century/early 18th century walnut and inlaid chest of drawers for £6,950 from Melody Antiques.

The fair had its share of overseas visitors taking advantage of the present currency situation, amongst which were four American funeral directors. They had flown in from Ocean City, Maryland for two weeks on an antiques buying spree.
